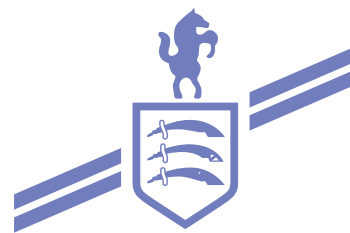

Welcome to the 2019 MCA Indoor Finals & end of season report. It's been an even more logistically demanding winter than last & due to very limited facility access & with the older age groups being accommodated at national level, it was decided to focus that what we could offer would be on the youngest groups. Initially, 11 clubs entered, each side were provided 6 randomly chosen matches with the top 4 progressing to the finals day.

The previously unbeaten Stanmore Lions played Tower Hamlets in the 1st semi & Hornsey overcame local rivals North Middlesex, reversing the league result, to claim their place in the final. Mahbubul Alam, coach of Tower Hamlets picks it up here.

U12s. The following weekend Primrose Hill & North Middlesex competed in Birmingham & came 5th & 6th respectively.

Over the winter other MCA clubs accepted invitations & enjoyed their match days in either Birmingham or Derby.

U14s. An 11 team league held over 3 match days. North Middlesex A came 2nd, Indian Gymkhana 6th, Hornsey 10th & North Middlesex B 11th

U16s. 4 groups of 4 with winners qualifying for a 2 group finals day. North Middlesex were the only MCA side to enter & finished 3rd in their Finals group

U18s. North Middlesex were the only side that entered & using U17s & younger, & there was further MCA colts' representation in the England U14 side who also competed at this level. North Middlesex finished 5th in a group of 7.

Girls from all clubs were invited but only an U22 competition was available for them as well as one for boys in which we did have further colt representation.

Last October for the first time, age group indoor world cups were held in Christchurch, New Zealand & all 3 England teams included boys from our clubs. A notable achievement indeed. It was amazing that so many MCA colts got through the selection process.



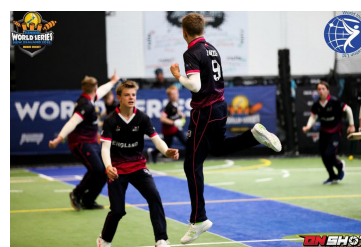
